**Project Title:** Reading and Writing Canada: Web Resource Guides in Research and Writing for Use in University Courses about Canada. Phase II - Web Resource Guides Integration and Implementation

**Project Summary** (150 words maximum)

Canadian Literature (CL) seeks to refine and expand its TLEF-funded (2011) online resource guides. The guides (launching in June 2012) draw on and enhance the accessibility of CL's vast online databases for students and teachers by (1) presenting modules focused on historical and thematic connections and questions for Canadian literary analysis, and (2) guiding students through critical assessment and writing skills for literary criticism. This next phase seeks to broadly publicize and integrate these guides into UBC courses through the development of information packages, departmental presentations, and integration meetings with instructors. To comprehensively test these guides, a graduate Teaching Assistant will also help develop and teach a course drawing extensively on the guides. These course integration meetings will inform the subsequent editing and expansion of the guides in terms of both user-friendliness and comprehensiveness based on student and teacher assessments and evaluations, developing a more refined second edition.
