Project Title: Enterprise Architecture Initiative (EAI): Engaging Students in Enterprise Architecture Knowledge.

Effective use of information technology (IT) has become crucial to the success of organizations and can have a significant impact on business competitiveness. Organizations need to (1) decide on the most valuable investment in IT and (2) effectively deploy, manage, and use IT resources.
