Project Title: The Terry Project on CITR - An interdisciplinary program exploring important global issues

Our proposal has no precedent in North American higher education. Unlike most university podcasts, which typically feature poorly recorded lectures, our aim is to create an entertaining and professional program with

broad appeal on and off campus. Our chief goals are to (1) connect UBC's fragmented community (with particular emphasis on commuter students); (2) advance the public discourse around important global issues;

and (3) serve as a valuable teaching, learning, and outreach tool for UBC faculty.
